Government Accountability Office (GAO) is an independent agency that works for Congress. The GAO watches over Congress, and investigates how the federal government spends taxpayers dollars. The Comptroller General of the United States is the leader of the GAO, and is appointed to a 15-year term by the U. S. President. The GAO wants to support Congress, while at the same time doing right by the citizens of the United States. They audit, investigate, perform analyses, issue legal decisions and report anything that the government is doing. This is one of their reports. The Secretary of the Interior should direct the Bureau of Indian Affairs to: develop and implement a system for gathering information on Indian students and the colleges they attend to help these students plan their education; encourage Indian counselors to perform duties that enhance the Indians opportunities to further their education; encourage colleges and universities without Indian counselors to see that Indian students are receiving adequate supportive services; develop regulations based on the higher education program manual and require BIA personnel to follow them; and...
