It concentrates on proposals for improved minority rights under the new government. This report is being published to coincide with the Helsinki Conference on Minorities in Southeast Europe held in Copenhagen in April 1990. It argues that the rights of minorities in Romania should be extended and promoted, and that Hungarian-language and other minority-language education should be reinstated. It also urges action from the international community to urge Romania to respect and implement its international human rights obligations.
